As you are aware, Midwestern Gas Transmission Company (MGT) has proposed the construction of an extension of its existing pipeline system in Sumner and Trousdale Counties in Tennessee (MGT Eastern Extension Project). On June 6, 2005 MGT filed its application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the MGT Eastern Extension Project with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC), which assigned the application Docket No. CP05-372-000.

As part of its application, MGT provided a Phase I Cultural Resources Survey report to the FERC and the Tennessee Division of Archaeology. FERC subsequently requested additional information related to architectural resources in the Project area. Consequently, MGT's cultural resources contractor developed a report entitled "Phase I Architectural Reconnaissance Survey For Midwestern Gas Transmission Company's Eastern Extension Project, Sumner and Trousdale Counties, Tennessee."
